

## Electrical Outlets

### What are the outlets like in Panama?

Panama uses North American non-grounded (two-prong) and grounded outlets, which run on a current of 110-120 Volts. Travelers from the US and Canada will not need voltage converters.

### Will my electronic devices work there?

Because of the possibility of either non-grounded or grounded outlets, an adapter may be necessary for some high end electronic devices which have 3-prong chargers (cameras, video-cams, laptops). **The 'Don't bring it' Guideline:** Don't bring anything you have to plug in, especially if it has to do with your hair; running too many at once can trip the circuit breakers.
